This week, we will finish chapter one in our Everyday Math series. Written Math homework will only be given on Tuesdays and Thursdays of each week. It MUST be returned the following school day! You will receive a Homework mark on your ROAR chart if it does not come back the next day.

Foundations homework will come home on Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday. It should only take a few minutes to complete. KEEP the stapled pages IN your BLUE TAKE HOME FOLDER. I will check it the following morning and leave it in their for you to complete the next night's sections.
