(Spelling Quick Check 10-18 in Foundations, mastery of the SKILL is assessed NOT memorizing words. There will be NO spelling words sent home to memorize/study for a typical spelling test.

Grammar skill: Plural Nouns

Wow word:

flimsy - weak or lightweight

clench - to squeeze tightly

infant - a baby

Brim - the edge of a cup or bowl

Omit - to leave out

Students are to learn this word AND its meaning. They WILL be TESTED at a later date over these words and their meanings.
