Just like the last 9 weeks, we are continuing to check out 2 books from our library that are on our level. Some students have begun reading chapter books. Students may take their books home, but they MUST BE RETURNED each day. I have books in the classroom

AND
The weekly reading story DOES COUNT. That means students only need 1 other book. Students may also read books from home and bring them in to complete the Exit Ticket/book report. Time is given to complete the exit tickets during Reading centers and each morning.

Last 9 weeks, we had students in the 30s and 40s for books and exit tickets!!!! Let's see who can read the most this 9 weeks! A prize will be awarded for the student who reads the most AND a class prize will be awarded to everyone IF everyone completes their goal of 10 books.
