Fundations Spelling sounds: Unit 10 week #1 our skills with this lesson are; double vowel syllable types, sounds of ai and ay & homophones

(<u>Spelling Quick Check Feb. 7 - in Fundations</u>, mastery of the SKILL is assessed NOT memorizing words. There will be NO spelling words sent home to memorize/study for a typical spelling test.

Grammar skil: more practice with adjectives

Wow words:
